

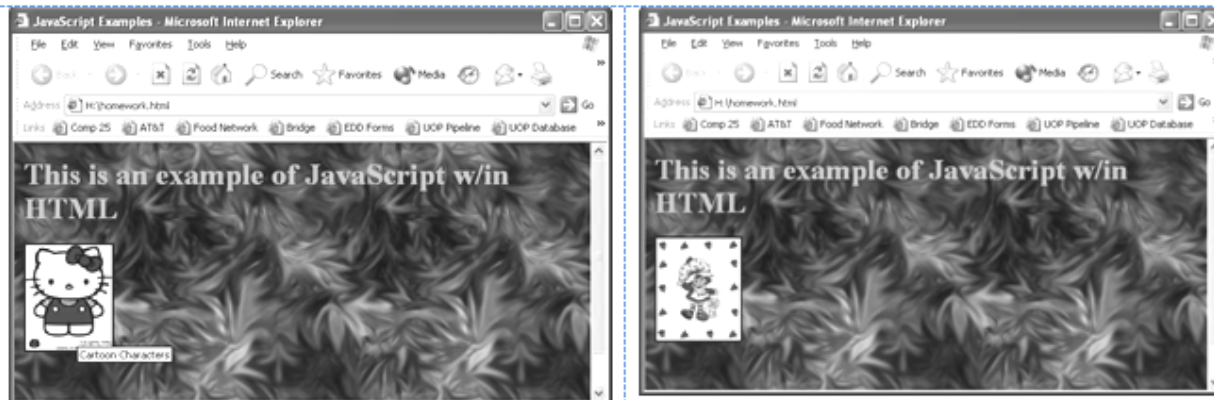
1) Alert – (easiest script)



Type the following script into your resume page, directly beneath the <BODY> tag

```
<script language="Javascript">
<!--
alert ("Insert your own information here!")
//-->
</script>
```

2) MouseOver pictures



Replace your tag in the resume with this code. This is an easy java script since it doesn't require <SCRIPT>...</SCRIPT> on/off tags but rather is extending upon the html <A HREF> tag. In this example, the user will return to your index.html page when clicking on the mouseover image. Replace the filenames below with your own filenames. Creates a link to your index.html page

```
<CENTER>
<a href="index.html"
onMouseOver='document.images.dance.src="hellokitty.jpg" '
onMouseOut='document.images.dance.src="strawberry.jpg" ' >
<img src='strawberry.jpg' name='dance' width=75 height=75></a> </CENTER>
```

3) Pop up / Message box



This script requires two steps:

1. Add this script in the <HEAD> section of your resume page, after your <TITLE></TITLE> tag

```
<SCRIPT LANGUAGE="JavaScript">  
<!-- Beginning of JavaScript -
```

```
function MsgBox (textstring) {  
alert (textstring) }
```

```
// - End of JavaScript - -->  
</SCRIPT>
```

2. Add this script beneath the <BODY> tag

```
<FORM>  
<INPUT NAME="text1" TYPE=Text>  
<INPUT NAME="submit" TYPE=Button VALUE="Show Me"  
onClick="MsgBox(form.text1.value)">  
</FORM>
```

4) Today's date and day -- using arrays (hardest!)

Insert beneath the <BODY> tag



```
<script language="Javascript">  
<!--
```

```
var dayName = new Array ("Sunday", "Monday", "Tuesday", "Wednesday", "Thursday",  
"Friday", "Saturday")
```

```
var monName = new Array ("January", "February", "March", "April", "May", "June",  
"July", "August", "September", "October", "November", "December")
```

```
var now = new Date
```

```
document.write("<H3>Welcome! Today is." + dayName[now.getDay()] + ", " +  
monName[now.getMonth()] + " "+now.getDate() +".</H3")
```

```
//-->  
</script>
```
